



Jury Report

Urban Toilets

On Tuesday 14/07/2026 at 3:00 pm (CET) Terraviva officially closed the submission of the proposals for the contest entitled "Urban Toilets". On Wednesday 15/07/2026 the jury panel received all the submitted proposals in digital format, together with the instructions about the evaluation procedure and the evaluation criteria previously published in the official competition brief.

The evaluation phase lasted 9 days, and, on Friday 24/07/2026 the jury members expressed their votes and the awarded projects were selected. The jury deliberates by mutual agreement the Final Ranking (mentions and finalists are ordered by registration code).

The evaluation procedure of "Urban Toilets" can be considered concluded. Once the jury board was officially dissolved, Terraviva proceeded with the verification of the identity of the authors of all the awarded projects.

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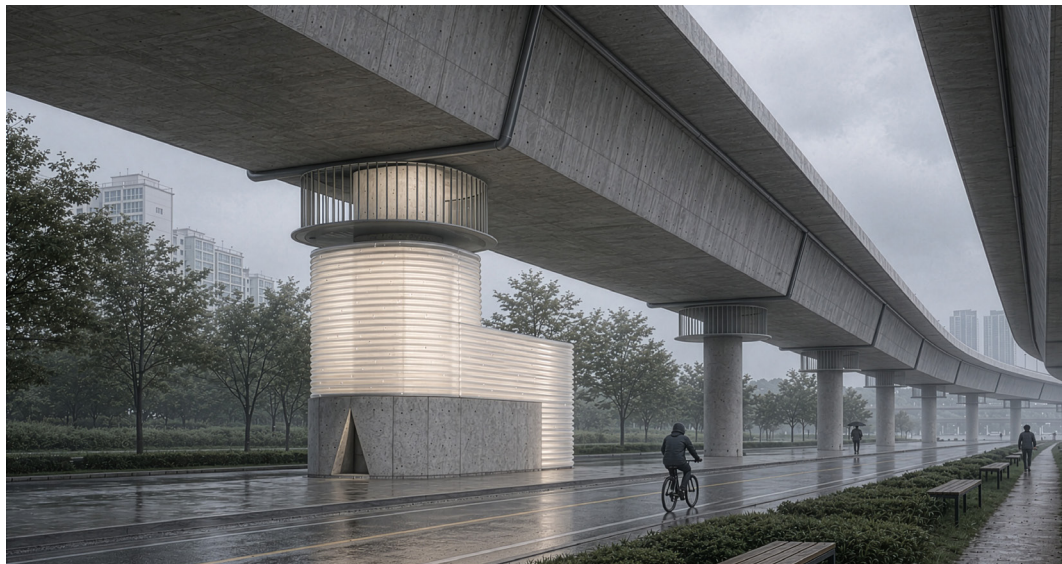

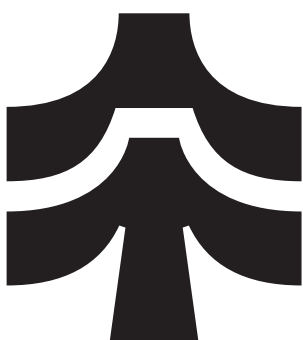

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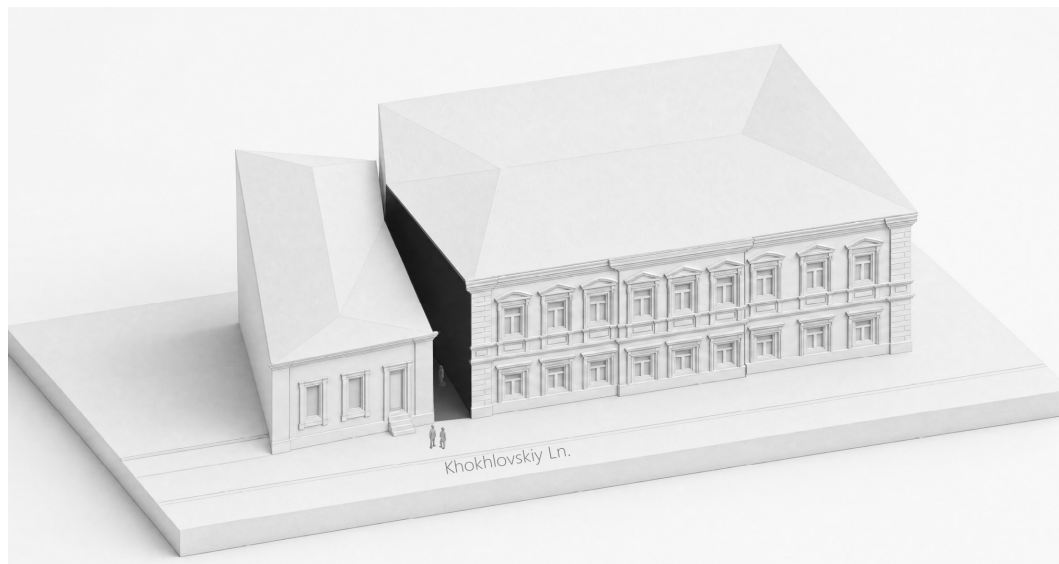
